KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission is now accepting applications for the following suballocated funding programs: Surface Transportation (STP), Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) and the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) – Ohio. STP funds are flexible funds from the Federal Highway Administration awarded to the MPO to fund a variety of multimodal and roadway projects that may be used by states and localities for projects as outlined in 23 U.S.C Section 133(b) or (c). TAP funds on-and-off road facilities for bicyclists and pedestrians and other enhancements to surface transportation as outlined at <http://www.fhwa.dot.gov/map21/guidance/guidetap.cfm>. CMAQ-Ohio program funds are designed to implement transportation projects and programs that improve air quality.

#### **Eligibility**

Eligible applicants are limited to cities, townships, counties, school districts and transit agencies located within the Huntington, WV-KY-OH Transportation Management Area (TMA). The TMA includes: Cabell and Wayne counties in West Virginia, Boyd and Greenup counties in Kentucky, and Lawrence County in Ohio.

#### **Application Submission**

To apply for funding, an Intent-to-Apply form and a Project Application must be completed and submitted to KYOVA Interstate Planning Commission as outlined below.

                  Intent to Apply: July 1, 2015 to July 31, 2015 (close of business)  
                  Project Application Deadline: September 4, 2015 (close of business)
